### **Where does the bus go?**

There are two buses running between the three event areas (all within a 1 mile radius): Swift Diamond Riders Warming Hut, Coleman State Park, and Coleman Estates. There is a sign at each drop-off/pick-up location and the buses are running constantly. All of the locations are accessible by trail or by walking as well.

### **What is at each location?**

#### **Swift Diamond Riders Warming Hut:**

- Groomer Rodeo
  - 9-3 both days
  - Come check out the new groomers before you buy!
- Food is available at the Warming Hut

#### **Coleman Estates:**

- Tubing
  - Free; parents will need to sign liability waivers
- Ice skating
  - Free; bring your own skates
- Mac&Cheese Cook-off
  - Saturday from 11am-1pm
  - People's Choice winner announced at 1pm
  - Come sample and vote!
- Snowshoeing
  - Snowshoes are available at the Coleman Estates Lodge
  - There are some nice, well marked trails so you can head out at any time
  - Guided tours leaving at promptly at noon each day
- Winter Wilderness Survival demonstrations
- Electric Bike Demos
- Lawn Games

- Helicopter Rides
  - For a fee
- Meat Raffle
  - Hosted by the local Legion
  - In Diamond Hall on Saturday
- Light Lunch available at Coleman Estates Lodge

### **Coleman State Park:**

- Three food vendors
- Demo new sleds & toys from Polaris, Ski-Doo, Arctic Cat, Argo
  - \$10 to demo per person (except Argo)
- Check out the antique tent and vote for the People's Choice Award
- Bolt Depot - all the nuts and bolts you might need
- State Agencies will be in attendance
- Clothing vendors

### **Where are the bathrooms?**

- Swift Diamond Riders Warming Hut
- Coleman Estates Lodge and Diamond Hall
- Coleman State Park Bathhouse
- Portable toilets will also be available around the event areas

### **What are some of the events (times & days)?**

- Mac&Cheese Cook-off on Saturday, 11am-1pm at Coleman Estates
- Guided snowshoe tours leave at noon from Coleman Estates both days
- All other events are available from 9am-3pm both Friday and Saturday
